


Lake Kamakita (Reservoir Hazard Map) * Map p. 16, D-2

What is reservoir hazard map?

Reservoir hazard map is designed to support residents' actions in case of danger such as early evacuation when reservoirs collapse or have a risk of collapsing due to earthquake or heavy rain, and to prevent and to reduce damage by indicating zones where flooding is expected. Be sure to take caution that the risk of flood also exists in locations outside the expected flood zones indicated on the map.
